Brief Report on the Reunion, Association meeting and History Tour in Philadelphia, and WWII History Symposium 8<sup>th</sup> Armored Division Association – September 13 -14 - 15, 2013

A group of 23 including 8 WWII veterans met on Friday evening September, 13, 2013 at the Radisson Hotel in Trevose, PA to hold the annual Reunion dinner and meeting of the 8<sup>th</sup> Armored Division Association, discuss the reunion, projects, and elect 2014 officers. Association President, Andy Waskie called the meeting to order and presented the meeting agenda. After opening introductions and greetings, an invocation was delivered on behalf of the Association Chaplain Rev. James Christiansen. Election of officers for 2014.

After a lively discussion of future events and projects of the Association, a reception was enjoyed by all attendees with refreshments and beverages.

Attendees enjoyed a large display of artifacts, photos, books, documents, and souvenirs of the 8<sup>th</sup> Armored Division veterans as provided by Anthony Adamsky, and WWII Reenactors, and members.

On Saturday, a contingent of Association members and 8<sup>th</sup> Armored Division veterans departed the hotel a history tour of sites and institutions in Philadelphia.

The itinerary included visits to the Independence Park with visits to the Liberty Bell, Independence Hall, the Union League, German Society of Pennsylvania, and a driving tour of the historic areas.

The group enjoyed a luncheon at a Spring Garden area restaurant near the German Society. On Sunday, the group departed the Hotel to travel to the historic West Laurel Hill Cemetery in the beautiful Conservatory where the attendees enjoyed a WWII History Symposium and displays of WWII gear, weapons, and equipment, as well as reenactors of the 28<sup>th</sup> Division At the conference attended by 100, including 30 WWII veterans, a superb luncheon buffet was served. The Conference featured 14 WWII veterans speaking about their individual service and experiences gathered together in themed panels.

All agreed that they enjoyed the Reunion and Tour, and it was also agreed by the Association officers that there would be future 8<sup>th</sup> Armored Division Association Reunions. Time and place to be determined.


